The Lange family's ALKOOMI vineyards and winery are located in the cool Frankland River region in the far south of Western Australia. Since climatic conditions are similar to those of the classic grape growing regions of France, it is not surprising that Frankland River produces some of the best wines made in Australia. The name ALKOOMI is taken from local aboriginal dialect and means 'a place we chose'. The logo represents the distinctive Australian grass tree which grows majestically in the area.

## 2009 SEMILLON SAUVIGNON BLANC

This excellent wine is made from carefully selected grapes grown in the Alkoomi estate vineyards located in the Frankland River region of Western Australia.

**Vintage:** A cool but sunny start to the growing season-promoted excellent vine growth and good fruit set. This was followed by a ripening season with bright sunny days and cool nights allowing for exceptional flavour development.

**Colour:** Pale straw with light green hue, brilliant clarity.

**Bouquet:** Hints of freshly cut grass, bountiful floral aromas, and a spicy background of vanilla and ground nutmeg.

**Palate:** Full, rich and flavourful wine with upfront tropical characters, melded with layers of sweet freshly cut grass and asparagus. A spicy influence of ground nutmeg lingers in the background. This long finishing wine is enticing to the last drop.

**Cellaring:** While best enjoyed when young and fresh, this wine will develop further if cellared for a few years.
