



ALKOOMI

The Lange family's ALKOOMI vineyards and winery are located in the cool Frankland River region in the far south of Western Australia. Since climatic conditions are similar to those of the classic grape growing regions of France, it is not surprising that Frankland River produces some of the best wines made in Australia. The name ALKOOMI is taken from local aboriginal dialect and means 'a place we chose'. The logo represents the distinctive Australian grass tree which grows majestically in the area.

This excellent wine is made from carefully selected grapes grown in the Alkoomi estate vineyards located in the Frankland River region of Western Australian

Vintage:	Cool summer nights led into bright and sunny autumn days, ideally suited to the development of vibrantly flavoured Sauvignon Blanc fruit.		
Colour:	Pale straw with light green hue, brilliant clarity.		
Bouquet:	Tropical characters of pineapple and melon abound and meld together with fresh gooseberry aromas and hints of fresh citrus.		
Palate:	Vibrant flavours of passionfruit and gooseberry fill the front of the palate and linger through the generous finish with sweet tropical and citrus flavours.		
Cellaring:	Most attractive when young, with careful cellaring this wine has the ability to develop in the short term.
