The ALKOOMI vineyards and winery of Merv & Judy Lange are located in the Frankland River district of Western Australia's Great Southern wine region. Since climatic conditions are similar to those of Bordeaux in France, it is not surprising that this region produces some of the best wines made in Australia. The name ALKOOMI is taken from local aboriginal dialect and means 'a place we chose'. The logo represents a distinctive Australian plant which grows in the area.

2004 Wandoo Semillon

The cool climate and gravelly loam soils of the Frankland River Region in the south of Western Australia are well suited to the production of intense and elegantly structured wines.

Each year a small plot of mature Semillon vines in Alkoomi's Frankland River vineyard produces exceptional fruit with intense aromas and mouth filling flavours. Sophisticated winemaking techniques including partial fermentation in new French oak casks and ageing on yeast lees have created a wine of great complexity.

Growing Region: Frankland River, Western Australia

Vintage: A cool cloudy spring, followed by a cool, dry summer led to excellent conditions for the ripening of our Semillon.

Colour: Mid straw with brilliant gold highlights.

Bouquet: Ripe nectarine with obvious sweet lemon aromas and the beginning of toasty bottle age characters.

Palate: Fine sweet lemon and grassy flavours with fine vanillin oak seamlessly woven with the mid-palate fruit, finishing long, fine and crisp.

Cellaring: At least five years.

Alcohol: 12.3% pH: 3.04
