

## **2005** Range

Made from fruit off Bannockburn's oldest vineyard planted in 1974 with 4 acres of Shiraz and 1 acre of Malbec. Dark red in colour with a red hue. Bright, clear appearance. Very attractive and inviting smoky nose with hints of bacon and smoked meats, dark fruits in there as well. Some lifted spice but very savoury. The palate is rich and round. Quite complex with different flavors and characters emerging - dark fruits, anise, chocolate and spice. It is a big wine, still quite fresh and lifted. Good quality tannin structure at the back of the palate.

Range is a single-block super shiraz. Gorgeously rich and complex, it has spicy, plummy fruit and lovely texture with subdued power and great length. New oak has dissolved seamlessly into the wine, which has superb balance.
