

2022 WATERVALE RIESLING

BACKGROUND

Mount Horrocks Wines is operated by proprietor/winemaker Stephanie Toole, who restricts production to approximately 3,500 cases per annum in order to achieve her aims of quality and single vineyard expression.

VINEYARDS

The remote, isolated Mount Horrocks Watervale Riesling vineyard planted by Stephanie in 2001, sits in the north eastern corner of the Clare Valley's Watervale subregion, on the very edge of the highly prized red soil over limestone.

VINIFICATION

The 2022 Mount Horrocks Watervale Riesling is a beautiful, delicious wine, its concentration reflecting the carefully managed crop load and excellent health of the vines..

The intensity of flavour and balance this wine exhibits are a delight – a convincingly drink-me-now wine that will age beautifully.

TASTING NOTES

Enticing spring florals and lime.

Delicate, coiled spring-like ready to expand with time. Classic citrus and mineral tones, all texture and length, vibrant and moreish.

Will age in the long term: 15 years plus.
