Handpicked, hand-sorted, gently destemmed and berry sorted. Fermented in small batches in the traditional manner with some whole bunches included in the ferment. Matured for 12 months in French oak."

Mozart Piano Concerto No.27 in B Allegro (part 3) Gentle, light but with weighty moments - playful and sophisticated.



PIERRO Pino'S 2013

Very much in the style of previous vintages of PIERRO Pinot yet with more body and depth of flavour – a spicy, peppery lift to the raspberry, strawberry flavours. It has the lightish frame and the fleshy texture of previous Vintages which give it a delicious immediacy. However, the addition of shiraz appears to indicate that it will develop complexity and further depth with up to five years cellaring. Perfect with Chinese roast duck especially when served slightly chilled on those warm balmy evenings.
