The Estate wine portfolio showcases the stylistically different varietals that Western Australia can produce to suit its casual and sun-drenched Mediterranean lifestyle.

The wines in this range are predominantly crafted from single vineyard sites in specific plots that have been selected for their distinct flavour profiles for each of the regions. The range includes Chenin Blanc, sparkling Chenin Blanc, Sauvignon Blanc, Chardonnay, Shiraz, Cabernet Sauvignon, and Verdelho.

COLOUR

Pale strawberry hues

NOSE

Exudes cherry spice and savoury aromatics

PALATE

The nose merges seamlessly into a creamy palate in this Rosé, which is a blend of Grenache, Shiraz, Chenin Blanc, and Viognier. Expect fairy floss and fresh summer berry characters in this well-balanced wine that has a slightly chalky texture and soft finish.

FOOD PAIRING

Medley tomato salad with grilled pesto chicken or fresh Asian spring rolls with a Vietnamese salad

WINEMAKING

A free-run juice of three varieties was used in this wine. The Grenache and Shiraz were fermented separately and blended post-ferment, where it was then allowed to settle for two months in stainless steel tanks.

VINTAGE

Mild, optimum fruit-ripening conditions in what was a perfect vintage.
