Intense, fresh, preserved lemon aroma, the palate is light but intense, even shrill, with again intense lemon juice and lightly-toasted almond notes. The palate is lean, taut and fine, and is attractive drinking although it is still a baby. It has a very clean, refreshing, almost nervy finish. The wine has extraordinary intensity and promises to reward cellaring. A great chardonnay.
