DRY GROWN MONTEPULCIANO

The 2021 Eden Valley Montepulciano is a 'pretty' version of an Italian classic. Dried petals on the nose mixed with elegance and structure, this is a truly one-of-a-kind from the Barossa Valley.

VINEYARD

A cold, shallow, sandy, hilltop vineyard enables this variety to slowly ripen, expressing its full elegance, yet simultaneously embracing structure and a fine tannin profile.

WINEMAKING

This wine is picked predominantly on acid balance. Rather than wait for flavour concentration, we pick as soon as the acid profile has softened – unlike the rest of our wines. Cool fermentation in a stainless-steel open fermenter, followed by a short maturation in neutral, seasoned French oak displays the best of what this variety can offer out of the cooler Eden Valley.

TASTING NOTES
