Mount Horrocks Clare Valley Shiraz 2013

A delightful contrast between glossy black cherry and black plum fruit, dark chocolate and a bed of confident, firm tannins that promise a grand future. There's intensity and concentration to this vintage, yet it upholds a medium-bodied restraint and savoury, commanding tannin structure.

Mount Horrocks Clare Valley Nero d'Avola 2013

The second vintage from this Watervale vineyard. Great result for young vines. Grand potential. A beautifully fragrant nose of rose hip, musk, red apple and raspberry heralds an enticingly fruit-focussed and jubey palate, a berry fruits delight that holds its integrity thanks to well-focused acidity and firm, fine tannin grip.

Mount Horrocks Clare Valley Cabernet Sauvignon 2013

95 Points

One of the greats from Mount Horrocks. Fragrant violet aromas unite with mulberry and blackcurrent fruit of impressive depth and persistence, yet vibrant, lively and medium-bodied. It's scaffolded by confident, finely structured, chewy tannins, bright acidity and well-gauged dark chocolate oak.
